# **TOGETHER WITH CHURCHES**

Meet Indwell's foundational community partners

The work of creating affordable housing for people seeking health, wellness and belonging depends on support from community partners, government representatives, individuals, and many more. When we each bring our strengths, skills and assets together, we can end homelessness and transform lives.

But there's no doubt that Indwell would not be what it is without the involvement of local churches. They are why we were able to launch this charity in 1974. While Indwell is not a church, we work closely with churches. Our tenants thrive when they are a part of the fabric of a faith community.

In our last newsletter, we introduced a new formal partnership that is in development with Hughson Street Baptist Church in Hamilton's north end. A generous grant from Stronger Philanthropy is helping Indwell explore, document and formalize this innovative partnership to gain the capacity to duplicate it elsewhere. "Our church specifically has gotten involved with this issue because as we read through Scripture, we see God calling us to care for others. What does it mean to care for them? You read Isaiah 1, and every word that's associated with caring for people is an action word from us to those that are more marginalized," says the pastor of Hughson Street Baptist Church, Dwayne Cline. "Then we said, what about housing? What about a place where people could live? We own a piece of property ... and our church agreed that we should put housing in with our new church facility on this property on James Street [North] in downtown Hamilton."

# **GROWING EAST**

Church communities at the forefront of upcoming expansion into Mississauga

At Indwell's Resource Centre, we receive emails and phone calls every week from various sources, all interested in replicating some part of Indwell's model. Amid these conversations, occasionally a clear overlap of vision and goals leads to a new development.

Around four years ago, two churches from Mississauga – Portico and Meadowvale Community Christian Reformed Church – started engaging with Indwell based on the needs they were seeing in their community. Indwell worked with Meadowvale to do a Community Needs Assessment to better understand where and how these churches could best step in to serve their neighbours.

It quickly became evident that there was a high need for affordable rents and supported homes in Mississauga. A 2016 report on housing indicated that in the region of Peel, only 252 units of affordable housing exist for individuals requiring mental health support, while 1,093 people are waiting for one of these units to become available. Long wait times for individuals in dire need are part of what compels Indwell to move into Mississauga. "The mismatch is so stark," says Sylvia Harris, Indwell's Project Developer for this region. "Although it's perceived to be a wealthier community, the social service needs are high and there are many gaps."

Indwell began to develop community relationships with political leaders, faith communities, and service providers. Recently, the team was mandated by Indwell's Board of Directors to make a concentrated push to develop a program in Mississauga. As we've begun to step forward into this new territory, Indwell has been deliberate about creating a model for expansion that will extend the organizational culture, knowledge and passion into this new region. Independent, affordable apartments with on-site supports are in the works.

"The church is the reason why we're going to Mississauga," says Sylvia. "They have been persistently knocking on our door for four years, and they will be critical partners going forward. Right now, finding land is our biggest obstacle. We're looking at creative models that may allow us to partner with churches and build around their sites to make an affordable housing project. We need them."

This step forward for Indwell is also a tremendous opportunity for new people and organizations to become familiar with Indwell. Who do you know in Mississauga who might support our vision, partner with us, and benefit from our housing?
